we are pleased to announce that the event originally scheduled for May 7 will now take place on **Thursday, June 4**. The current international situation and its implications for the global economy could not be more serious. All parameters are shifting, and it seems as though the “Year of the Fire Horse 2026” will see a repeat of exactly what led to significant upheavals 60 years ago. Unlike back then, however, the current conflict in the Middle East carries with it the danger of a new world war. The Islamic Republic of Pakistan, long closely linked to Germany and currently the hope that the confrontations will not escalate but rather subside, has become the key venue for dialogue and hope for a lasting peace. Expectations are high for the behind-the-scenes talks, which are taking place largely without European participation.
